With over a decade of experience as a successful entrepreneur, fund manager, philanthropist and board member, Moez brings a wealth of experience and creative energy to all that he does. He earned an MBA from the London Business School (LBS) and has a BA from Western University.

But before all, as he'll be the first to tell you, he is a graduate of Bayview Glen. Moez considers his experience at Bayview Glen as the 'blueprint' for building his successful academic and professional career.

Now, Moez is a principal at the Anson Group. In just eight years, he grew the Anson Investments Master Fund to a remarkable \$500 million - an achievement recognized by both *Bloomberg Magazine* as Top Ten Mid Cap Performing Hedge Fund, 2014 and Barclay's Top 10 Funds based on 3-year performance, 2011.

Alongside this demanding role, Moez applies his innate business acumen to the benefit of numerous charities,

including Second Harvest, Doctors Without Borders (MSF) and Athletes for Africa. He is a member of the Young Presidents Organization (YPO) and a member of the Board of Directors for Kids Cook to Care. He also moonlights as the Executive Producer for television and production house Moringa Media, where he provides the critical link between the worlds of business and art.

Extracurricular involvement isn't new for Moez. He was the first Bayview Glen student to embark upon a Round Square exchange, a live-study program in Australia. As an alumnus, he served as the first President of the Bayview Glen Alumni Association and generously donated the staff room to the building of the Moatfield campus.

His passion for food knows no bounds; Moez often travels great distances for a single meal and documenting it all in a food-focused Instagram account with thousands of followers. His epic dinner parties are the stuff of legends, and often benefit charities like Homes First and MSF. "Dîner en Blanc" Toronto, a chapter of the Paris-based dinner party sensation, recently took notice, naming Moez their CFO - "Chief Food Officer."
