We have been working with Toronto Public Health and I am happy to say they have completed their investigation.


As directed in the attached letter, the family and the class of the student in question will be required to self-isolate for 14 days. Homeroom Teachers teaching this class will also have to self-isolate. We are currently at day eight of this quarantine and it would appear that this is an isolated case. However, please continue to monitor your child for symptoms and be sure to complete your daily screening. We advise a low threshold of tolerance when deciding to send your child to school.

As Thanksgiving is just around the corner, please monitor your family's bubble especially if your children are involved in sport teams or other groups outside of school. If your child is involved in activities of this nature, please notify your Assistant Head of School or Homeroom Teacher/Mentor. We do need to be vigilant and keep our guard up.
