CLASSROOM NAMING



Bayview Glen's classrooms are set up to create an effective atmosphere in which learners feel safe and motivated to collaborate, co-operate and engage in the development of reading, writing and oral communication.

A gift of \$25,000 (payable over five years) to name a classroom will support ongoing upgrades to classroom equipment, enhancing of our technology and improvements to our existing facilities as well as leave a lasting legacy.



The 25 metre fully accessible indoor pool will be the pride of the Bayview Glen community.

Aquatic activities will be a welcomed new addition to the School's Health and Physical Education curriculum, introducing lifesaving, beginner and intermediate swimming lessons. Along with our instructional classes, we will offer open lane and recreation swim times for our older students. These activities will build skill, co-ordination, courage, physical well-being and teamwork. The pool will also be home to our Gryphons swim team of over 50 students who will no longer have to travel by bus to multiple off-site facilities.

Accessed from the ground floor, the pool area will include a viewing gallery, an office, equipment storage, change rooms, showers and washrooms. The facility will have natural light to reflect across the water.

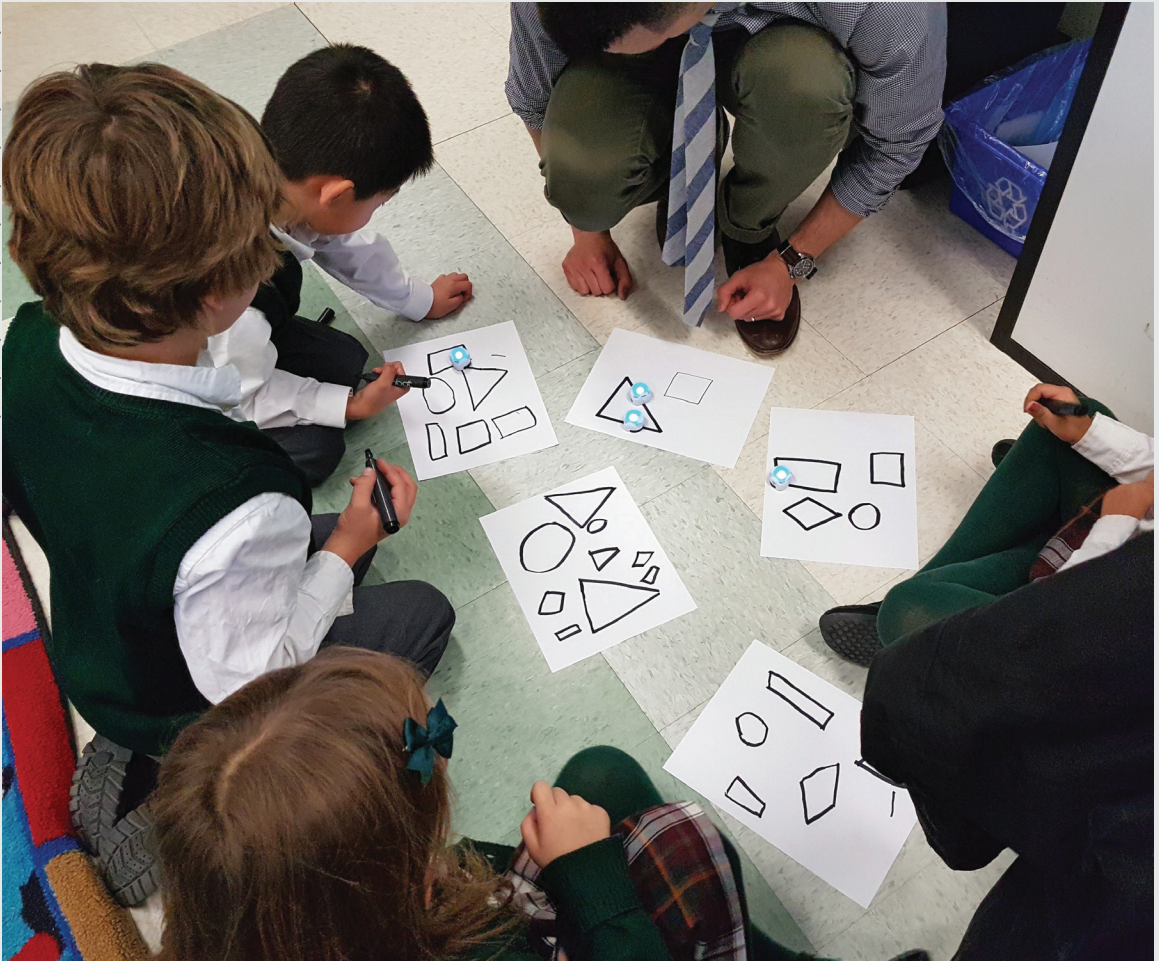
THE GLOBAL EDUCATION INITIATIVE



The Perspective to Thrive

Tied to our educational vision based on a *whole world* view, funding of this priority will enable us to design and deliver a comprehensive programme that engages all Bayview Glen students to investigate the world beyond their immediate environment through rigorous disciplinary and interdisciplinary study.

The programme will help develop the competencies necessary to understand and address complex global challenges and encourage our students to demonstrate leadership and autonomy in proposing and taking action on issues of importance to them as responsible citizens of the world.




Bayview Glen is deeply committed to student excellence. Bursaries and scholarships keep our microcosm vibrant. Experiencing our School's exceptional diversity gives Bayview Glen students a real advantage as they step out into the wider world.

To guarantee that the school continues to attract the best students regardless of their financial situation, Bayview Glen offers two ways donors can participate in helping us achieve this goal.

Named Endowed Scholarship or Bursary

An endowed scholarship or bursary is a donation of money or transfer of property with the stipulation that it be invested and that the principal remain intact in perpetuity. This allows the donation to have a long-term and enduring impact. An endowment must generate interest for a full year before disbursements can begin.

Starting at \$25,000, a **Named Endowed Scholarship or Bursary** can be established. This enables donors to allocate funds to their area of interest (for instance, mathematics, history or health and physical education) and specify what type of student(s) will receive the scholarship or bursary.
