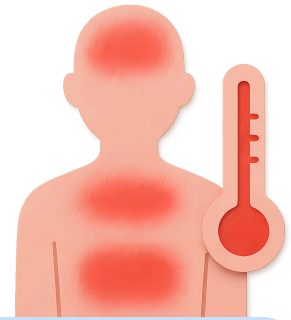


RETURN TO SCHOOL ILLNESS GUIDELINES



FEVER (38.0 DEGREES OR HIGHER)

- If your child has a fever, they must be fever-free for at least 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medications before returning to school.
- This 24-hour clock starts once they are fever-free without the use of fever-reducing medications (for example: Advil, Tylenol, etc).

1 EPISODE OF NAUSEA/VOMITING/DIARRHEA (N/V/D)

- For 1 episode of N/V/D, your child may return to school once they are 24 hours symptom-free, unless they are exhibiting other signs of illness.
- If any other symptoms are present, your child must stay home for a minimum of 48 hours.
- 24-48 hour clock starts once they are symptom free and feeling well.

2 + EPISODES OF N/V/D

- For two or more episodes of N/V/D, your child must remain at home for a minimum of 48 hours following the last episode.
- Seek medical attention for children who are experiencing severe or prolonged symptoms.
